Thanks to the Diocesan Parish Review Team, we did have the 'giftie' of seeing ourselves with an outsider's view. Mark, Susan and Gareth all had positive things to say about the warmth of our welcome, and the quality of ministry offered by us all. And while there were some recommendations for tweaks, the underlying messages were 1. Keep praying, and 2. Keep doing what you are doing.

We are seeing some exciting 'green shoots' as Mark would say (signs of growth). As we look around our congregations there are one or two new faces. In general newcomers are made to feel welcome - and indeed you are all very welcome. A Friday lunch group has been reinstated with St Mary's Soup Kitchen meeting fortnightly on the days St Andrew's Rest Awhile does not meet. We now have a group of high school students meeting weekly in the Upper Room to think about Jesus, God and the Bible. Our recent Lenten Studies on Lectio Divina were well received and many of you are adding the Lectio 365 app to your phones as an addition to your devotional lives. I believe these growth points are the direct result of the fervent prayer of so many of you for revival in our churches.

It would seem that around the Western world there is a quiet revival going on. With Pentecost coming up, there is a worldwide move to pray for it to continue. The 24-7 Prayer movement has proposed 10 days

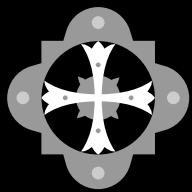
of round-the-clock prayer to prepare for Pentecost. I don't think we are quite brave enough to take that on, but we are taking part in a day of prayer organised by the Reverend Tim Handley (Westland), on behalf of the Diocese. It runs from 9am to 5pm, Saturday, 7 June 2025, with parishes round the diocese taking a turn. I've put us down for the 9am-10am slot. So come along to St Mary's at that time and be part of a diocesan wide prayer day. We can go and grab a coffee afterwards.

To my knowledge there are, or have recently been, three home groups in our parish. I believe that we would be strengthened if more of us belonged to such a group. I am not sure what the next step is, but I do believe that is where we are being led. I am welcome to suggestions. If any of you feel to host a group in your home, let me know and we can think and pray about it together.

By the time you read this the new vestry will have met. Please pray for my warden Paul Sagar who has agreed to serve another year, for Jan Hill, re-elected People's Warden, for members of vestry - Ann Armstrong, Barbara Cassidy, Mary Holmes, Cecil Hood, Chris Longson, and Gerald Pemberton - and for our synod representatives Barbara Cassidy and Cecil Hood (appointed in 2024 for a three-year term).

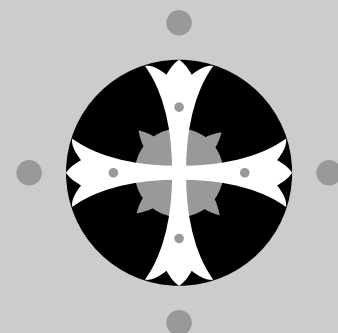

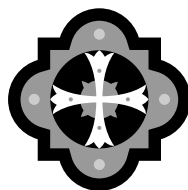
