## Greetings to the saints of Geraldine (as St Paul would say)

We are in the last few Sundays of the Green, in-between season, as we leave Christmas and Epiphany behind, and prepare to embark on Lent. Ash Wednesday is on 18 February. Back in the day, Lent was the season when catechumens were prepared for baptism at Easter. I know of one family preparing to bring a child to baptism, so please hold them in your prayers.

In the northern hemisphere, Lent was indeed a lean time, with not much to eat until late spring or early summer. So, the poor had to fast, like it or like it not. For many of us, Lent does bring the idea of introducing an element of challenge or sacrifice into our lives.

God does not want us to be miserable and takes no pleasure in it if we are.

Remember Micah 6: 6-7

*With what shall I come before the Lord  
and bow down before the exalted God?  
Shall I come before him with burnt offerings,  
with calves a year old?  
Will the Lord be pleased with thousands of  
rams, with ten thousand rivers of olive oil?  
Shall I offer my firstborn for my  
transgression, the fruit of my body  
for the sin of my soul?*

What does God want? He tells us:

*To act justly and to love mercy  
and to walk humbly with your God. (v8b)*

Simple but not easy. The challenge for you and me this Lent is not to engage in some kind of spiritual heroics. It is to remember that we belong to God, and that as we recognise that our fellow humans also belong to God, we are to love

them, be kind to them and to walk humbly with God. So God is not just for Sundays. As we enjoy God's presence in the Eucharist, we live it out in our lives for the other six days of the week.

Some of us will be thinking about the big picture of God's love for us as we work through The God Story by Adam Cox and Alain Emerson. It is not too late to join us. If you haven't already done so, you could put the app Lectio 365 on your phone and add a morning and evening prayer. For the enthusiasts, there is also a midday prayer.

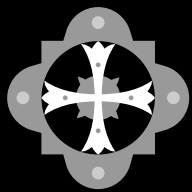
Whatever we do, let us do it joyfully as we prepare for Holy Week in April.

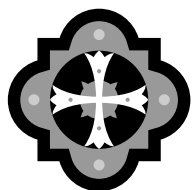

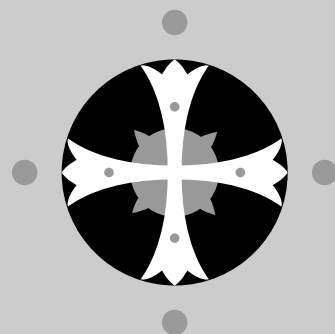
